

One-student-one-service Scheme (Inter-class Competition)

A. Aim

- ✧ to encourage students to take part in the community service
- ✧ to help students better understand and put into practice the school motto “Love & Service”
- ✧ to help achieve the all-round development of students through various social service activities, so that students can widen their social experience to adjust to social needs

B. Introduction

A one-student-one-service card and guideline sheet will be distributed to each student today. Once you render social service or specified school service (e.g., clean the campus), you can invite the person-in-charge to sign the card and assess your performance as excellent, good, satisfactory or unsatisfactory.

Deadlines for collection of One-student-one-service cards: 6/12/2010 for S7 students and 15/4/2011 for S1-S6 students.

An award „The Outstanding Service Class“ will be given to the class with the highest number of students who take part in rendering social service or school service (e.g., clean the campus).

C. Q and A for One-student-one service Scheme and Social Service

Award Scheme:

- 1) Q: Having rendered social service, can I invite the person-in-charge to sign and chop both Social Service Record Book and one-student-one-service card?
A: Of course, you can.

- 2) Q: If I cannot find the person-in-charge to sign and chop our card, what can I do?
A: You can provide some proof (e.g. a certificate or a letter) for the service to Miss Kwok of ECA Section. She will sign the book for you.

3) Q: Last year, I only signed the one-student-one-service card. The hours of social service did not count in my personal Social Service Award Scheme. Why?

A: You have to sign both card and the Social Service Record Book. If you only sign the card, this will be counted in the inter-class competition only (i.e., the One-student-One-Service scheme). Only the records in the service book will be counted into your personal records under the Social Service Award Scheme. Be careful this year!

4) Q: I am a S3 student. I have to join the S3 Eyes on the Community Service Program organized by the school this year. Having rendered the service, can I sign both one-pupil-one-student card and the Social Service Record Book?

A: You can meet the requirements of „S3 Eyes on the Community Service Program“, „one-pupil-one-service program“ and „social service award scheme“ at the same time.

5) Q: If I render service to schoolmates, will this service activity be recorded in my Social Service Record Book?

A: No, it will not because the main aim of Social Service Award Scheme is to encourage you to render service to the community outside your school. Only this kind of service will be recorded.

6) Q: If I lose my One-student-one-service card, what can I do?
