當日的天色昏暗密雲,間中還下著微微細雨, 氣溫只有十二、三度,但一班義工隊卻無懼風雨, 參與這次探訪。當天我帶著四位中二年級的學生, 拿著載有揮春、麥片、餅乾和藥品等的禮物包,浩 浩蕩蕩地出發,向長者們拜早年。

當天令我最難忘是探訪兩位婆婆。兩戶不同姓 氏的獨居婆婆,被房屋署安排住在同一個單位。一 位80多歲,另一位90多歲。一位耳朵不靈光,而另 一位則眼睛不靈光。兩位互不相識的獨居婆婆,可以 住在同一屋簷下,並且互相幫助,真是值得我們學 習。例如耳朵不靈光的婆婆之前聽不到我們義工打 給她的電話,而另一位婆婆則替她接聽,她們 活上互相協助,解決困難。當我們登門探訪時, 活上互相協助,解決困難。當我們登門探訪時,她們 高興地說:「同我傾下偈!我好開 心!」因為她們雙腳不良於行,甚少外出。所以, 我們送上的禮物,不單是物質上的饋贈,更是各同 學和義工家長關懷和溫暖。

This is the second year when I was given a chance to participate in the yearly elderly visit. I consider it as an honor for me to participate in such meaningful event. The event is usually organized before the Lunar New Year. It is a time when everybody wanted to conclude our "old" year whether bad or good and welcome our new year. We wanted our new year be blessed with good health and new progress. It is the same for the elderly, too. They welcome our girls because you symbolize energy, love and new hope.

We are given about 90 minutes to visit 4 households. In the other words we cannot merely distribute our "Fortunate Bag" and then go away. We are required to talk with the elders for sometimes and pay our concerns for them. It is not an easy task.

To talk with somebody you not known is a bite difficult especially for some shy ones. And on the contrary we should not be too talkative or else it is too lousy. It is the task for us as parents to regulate the atmosphere.

I remember in the first year of my visit we have to talk with a blind middle-aged to old man. I still miss him. I wish I can visit him every year. He is such an honest person. The girls are surprised because they do not have a close encounter with the blind before. They became nervous in this situation. His blindness was not inborn, it begins in his Teens. It happened when he was fighting happily with his own elder brother. Although tragedy happens he did not blame his elder brother for long. Besides he also told us his love story with his primary school classmate. Although the girl offered to live with him, he refused out of unselfishness. When we leave, he did not forget to bless our girls to have good progress in school works.

In the second year, we visit a couple who are over 85. They are just like our grandma and grandpa. With their background we can draw the "contour" of Hong Kong. The good old man only returned back to Hong Kong in the last 5 years. He was born in Hong Kong during the 20s last century. His mother died when he was two. Therefore, he was took care by the relative in the mainland. Meanwhile his own father was still working in Hong Kong as a tailor. When he grown up during the 40s he worked in a big factory ran by the Song's family in Shamsuipo. He took the night shift job because he was single in Hong Kong leaving his wife and children in the mainland. This is very common in those days because they could not afford such a "big" family in Hong Kong. The living standard in the mainland is lower just like the situation today. In his youth, he did not took care of his family who stayed in the Canton provinces. He drinks a lot. His wife had to support the family by her own in the mainland. She was once at the edge of blindness. He became awakened when he was 40. He later became a responsible man. After retirement he stayed more than 10 years in the mainland. He came back to Hong Kong with his wife who was then the first time coming to Hong Kong. Their story let me understand how hard it was to have a family stay together in the same place. We have to treasure our family union.

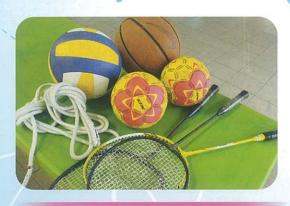

I was over the moon after visiting the elderly as I joined a meaningful activity. We should also join this kind of charity events to arouse the social awareness of everyone.
